Meet at noon, Eat at 1:00 P.M. At Kirby Park
182 E. River Rd Nichols, NY 13812

Directions: From the Towanda area and points south, take Route 220 N to Waverly, right turn onto I86 East (Route 17) Take exit 62 (Nichols/Tioga Downs) turn left onto W. River Rd, after 0.9 miles the park will be on your left. (that is just after you pass the Dollar General store)
You can also take PA187 from Wysox to Nichols. Once you enter NY State the route number will change to 282. In Nichols, after Sallies County Kitchen, at the intersection with River Rd, turn right, after 0.2 miles the park will be on your left.

From the Owego/Binghamton area take I86 West to exit 63 (Lounsbury) make a quick right onto Best Buy Road (NY 54) make a left at the T (signs says Tioga Golf Club Lounsbury) after 3.6 miles, the park is on your right after going over Wappasening Creek.
You can also take Old Route 17 West from Owego to the Tioga Downs exit. That is Route NY 282. At the intersection with W. River Rd, make a left and the park will be on your left after a mile.

Folks from Sayre can take the scenic River Road along the Susquehanna all the way to the park.

The fun officially starts at 11 A.M. when Dave Millis offers geode cutting and making spiders and copper rings as he did at the last picnic. At the July picnic, while showing some of our ladies how to craft wire spiders, a real spider hopped on the table. We cannot promise real spiders at this picnic however there will be lots to do. As always, if you have a rock or fossil that needs to be identified, bring it.
Adults can join the Pebble Pups in gold panning and other activities. The treasure hunt will be for kids only. There will be a marble run activity. If you plan on going to the creek, please do not wear your best clothes and footwear.
